Spring Break & Summer Camp Information

Thank you very much for your interest regarding The Lazy "H" Ranch camp programs. The camp has been in operation for fifteen years and has been a huge success.

Camp is offered for one-week sessions (Monday through Friday) during spring break and summer. Camp activities will begin at 9:00am and end at 4:00pm. Extended hours are available upon request. Riding camp is for children aged 6 to 13. No prior riding experience necessary.

Riding Camp Format

We will be dividing the children into age and riding level appropriate groups. **Each child will be assigned their own pony/horse to ride and take care of for the week.** We have new horses for intermediate to advanced riders and lots of safe ponies for beginners. Here is a tentative schedule of events.

Similar to last year we will be breaking throughout the day for snack and lunch. We will have a refrigerator at the ranch to store lunches and children must bring their own lunch. As long as legs and feet are covered up, the best clothes for the ranch are old ones! We recommend boots or strong tennis shoes (not the thin canvas type) for riding. We provide riding helmets for the children to ride in. For insurance purposes Bike Helmets are NO longer authorized for horseback use. Children may bring their own horseback riding approved helmet for use. Every year we are always surprised how quickly all of the children learn to ride and act like responsible individuals around ponies. Our philosophy is to teach total horsemanship and let each child advance at his or her own pace.

The cost of spring break camp **\$450** and summer camp is **\$475** per week a deposit of \$100/child will reserve a space. The deposit is only refundable if we can fill your reserved space

Discount for parents sending more than one child from the same family is **\$50.00** per child.

Discount for children attending more than one-week is **\$50.00** per week.

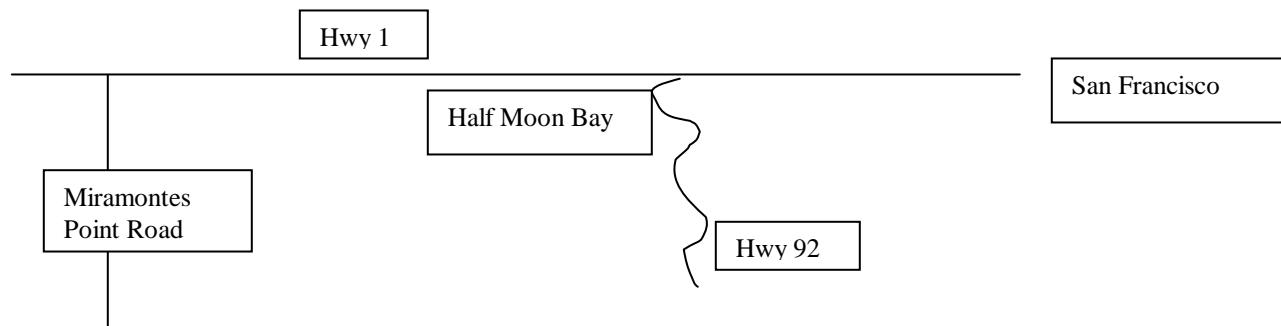

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RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND IDEMUNITY AGREEMENT

1. I understand there are risks in and around equine activities. Horses may without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble fall, rear, bite, kick, run, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's feet, push or shove a person –all which may cause the rider to fall or be jolted resulting in serious injury or death.
2. I understand that because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance, horseback riding, boarding, and the handling of horses in general are dangerous activities and involve risks that may cause serious injury, property damage or death.
3. I assume the risk and danger of injury, property damage, or death inherent in the use of the horse, equipment and gear provided for my use at The Lazy "H" Ranch provided by The Lazy "H" Ranch, myself or anyone else.
4. I release, discharge and promise not to sue The Lazy "H" Ranch and any of its owners, officers, employees and agents (hereinafter the "Releasees) for any loss, liability, damage or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage or injury (including death) to my person or property.
5. I release the Releasees from any claim that such Releasees are or may be negligent in connection with my riding experience or ability including, but not limited to, training, instruction on riding skills, supervising riders, selecting horses, maintenance care, fit or adjustment of riding equipment.
6. Indemnity and save and hold harmless The Lazy "H" Ranch and its employees and agents from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of, or in any way connected with either my use of the horse and any equipment or riding gear, whether any or all such is provided by The Lazy "H" Ranch, myself, or anyone else or, any acts or omissions of employees or other agents.
7. I agree to abide by and follow any instructions given or rules established by The Lazy "H" Ranch and its employees.
8. I agree that the forgoing release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement is governed by the laws of the State of California, and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by such law, and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the balance of the Agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way and shall continue in full legal force and effect.
9. I have read this agreement and understand that by signing this agreement I am giving up certain legal rights including the right to recover damages in case of injury, property or death. I have read this agreement and understand it is a promise not to sue and a release and indemnity for all claims.
